





MINUTES

On 28 February 2023, at 13 hours, an ad hoc jury was held, composed of Professor Claire Bright, Chair, Professor Athina Sachoulidou and Professor Laura Iñigo Álvarez, to assess the applications for Research Grant no. 2/2023, to be awarded for collaboration in the Postdoctoral Research Project of Dr. Laura Íñigo Álvarez, hosted by CEDIS, Centre for R&D in Law and Society (UI0714), NOVA University of Lisbon.

The jury began by verifying that five applications had been submitted to the competition. Following this, the jury carried out a formal analysis of the process, verifying that all applications complied with the requirements set out in the competition call.

Following analysis of the elements presented by the candidates, according to the evaluation parameters set out in the competition call, all five applications were admitted and scored, and the jury decided to award the scholarship to the candidate ranked under **number 2**:
